



# Eftpos Checklist

- 1 Do you have a business bank account setup? If yes great, if no we can point you in the right direction.
- 2 You may only be browsing at this stage, you can start a conversation well before you are even opening. Even if you're six months out, you may be the organised type - get in touch today.
- 3 When you process EFTPOS transactions, there is also a monthly Network fee. The network will tell you if the transactions have accepted or declined. (Head to 'How it Works' to understand how EFTPOS works and who is involved?)
- 4 Do you have a Point of Sale system (POS) or a cash register that needs to connect with the EFTPOS terminal? Maybe you want one? We work with many POS developers. Discuss your needs, and we can direct you in the right direction.
- 5 Do you have a premise lined up? It's important to know what connections you will have available for EFTPOS. We have a variety of EFTPOS terminals that can use different connections from the internet (broadband cable or WiFi), 3G, and in some cases phone line (this is becoming more redundant).
- 6 Your business, are you set up as a limited company, trust or even a sole trader? This is important to know as there are different requirements for example how many people need to sign.
